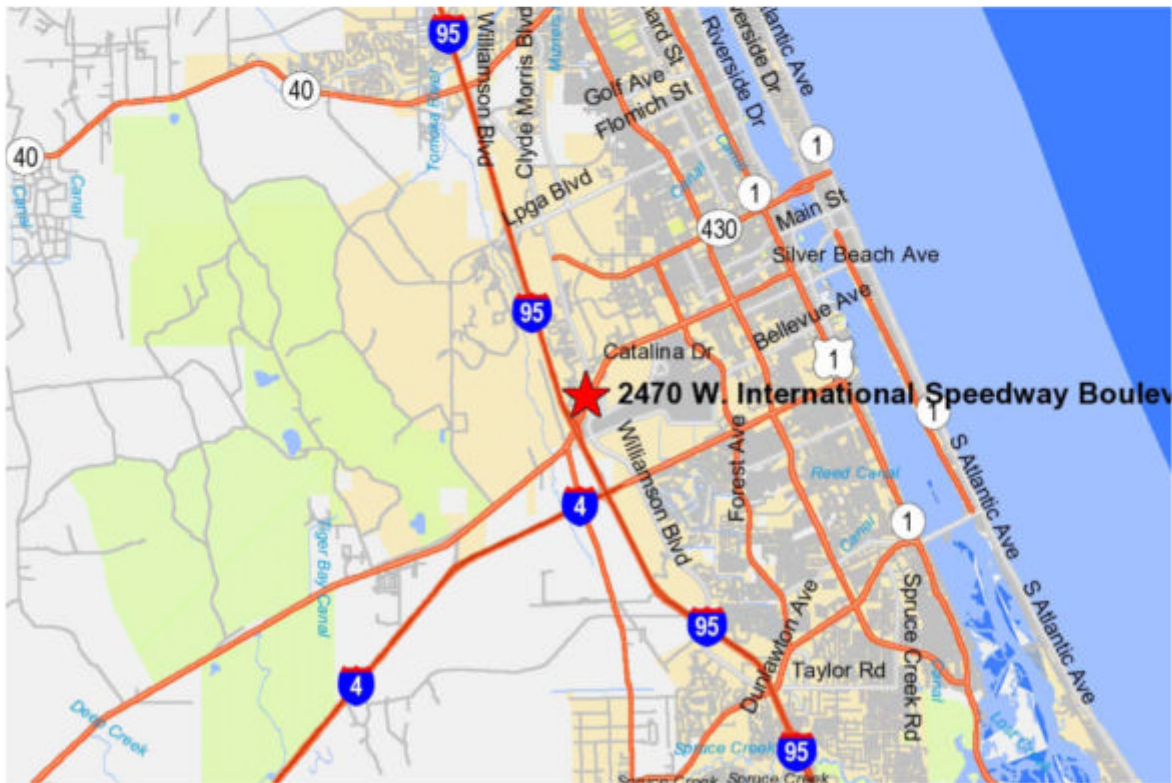

LOCAL MAP

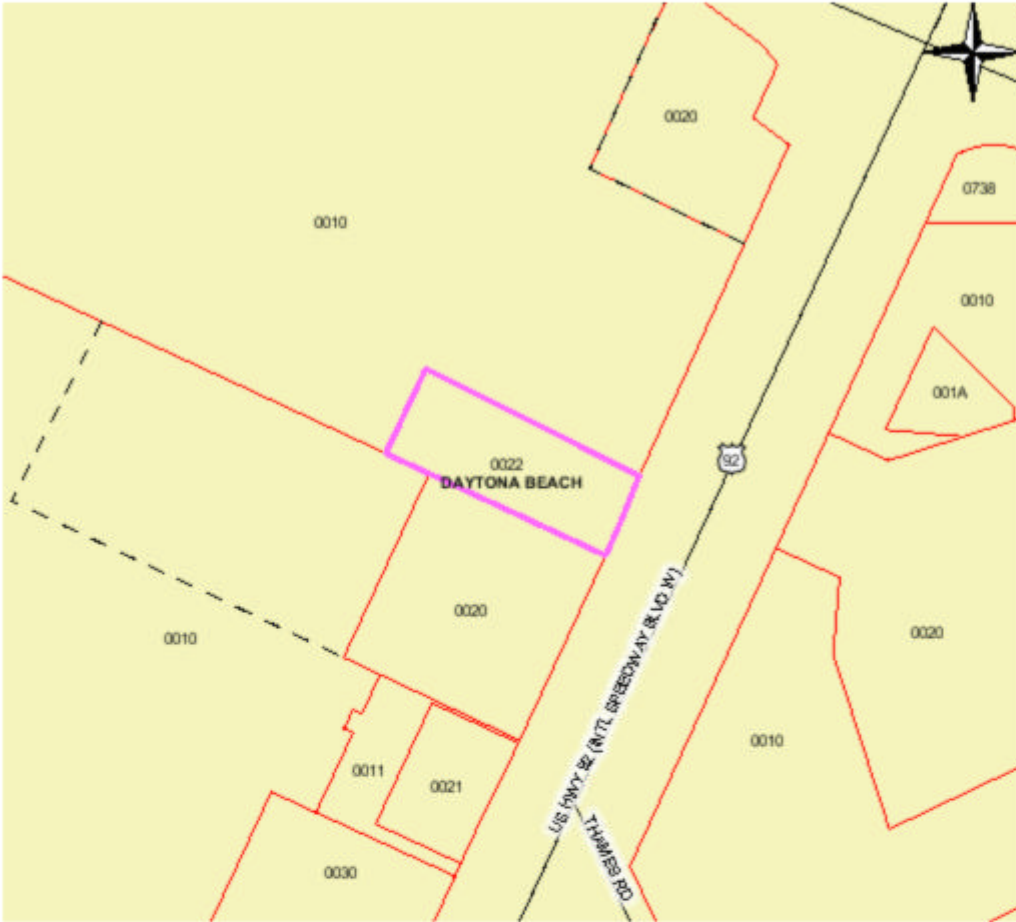


REGIONAL MAP

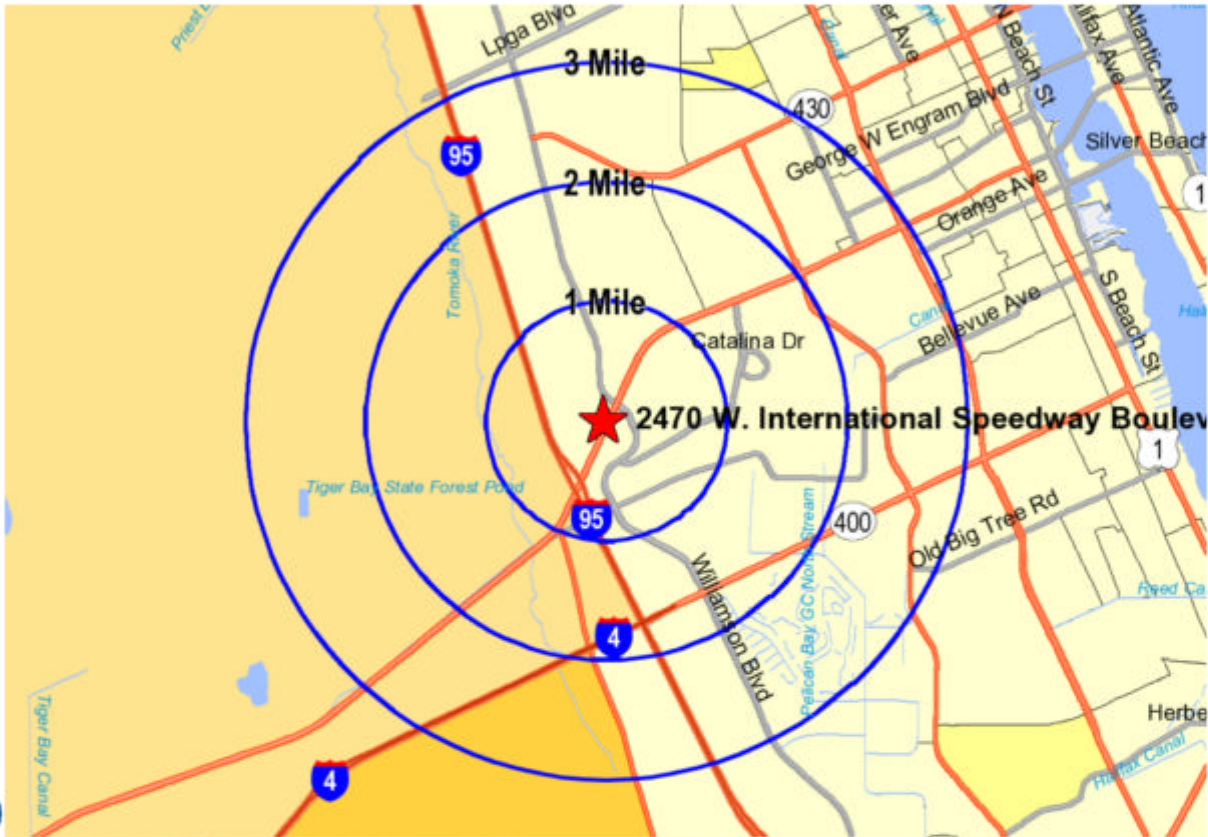
